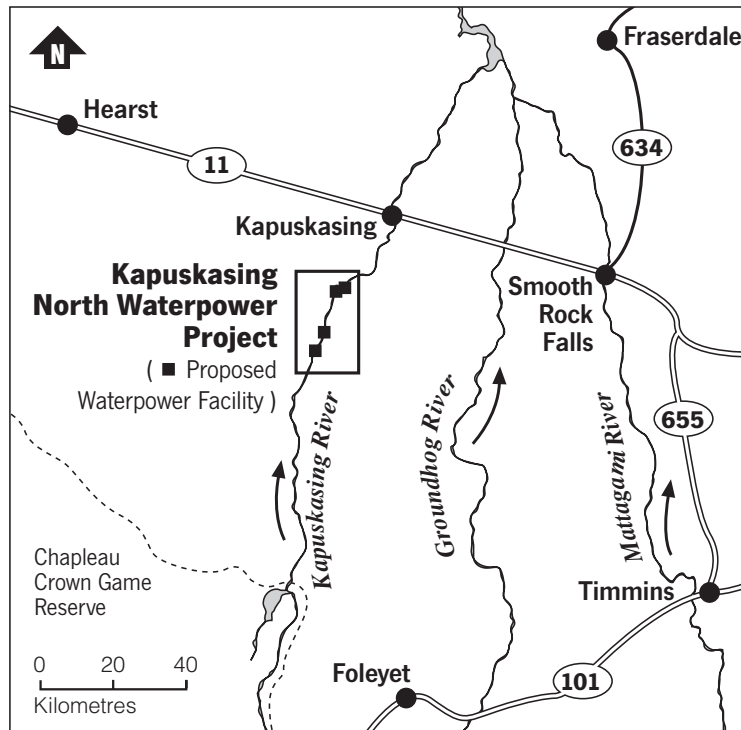

Environmental Screening/Review and Water Management Plan Amendment

Kapuskasing North Waterpower Project

Hydromega Services Inc. (HSI), in collaboration with First Nations (Chapleau Cree, Brunswick House Ojibway and Chapleau Ojibway), are proposing to develop four run-of-river waterpower facilities in the river reach located approximately 17-45 km south of Kapuskasing Ontario. The facilities would be located at Big Beaver Falls, Camp Three Rapids, White Otter Falls and Old Woman Falls. Each facility would have an installed capacity of 5 MW and would consist of a surface power house containing two turbines, an overflow weir and associated structures. A new 25 kV transmission line would be constructed to connect to existing transmission facilities.



A Public Information Centre (PIC) is being held to present information regarding the design and operation of the facilities, provide information on the environmental screening/water management planning process, and receive input/feedback regarding the project. The PIC will be held at:
